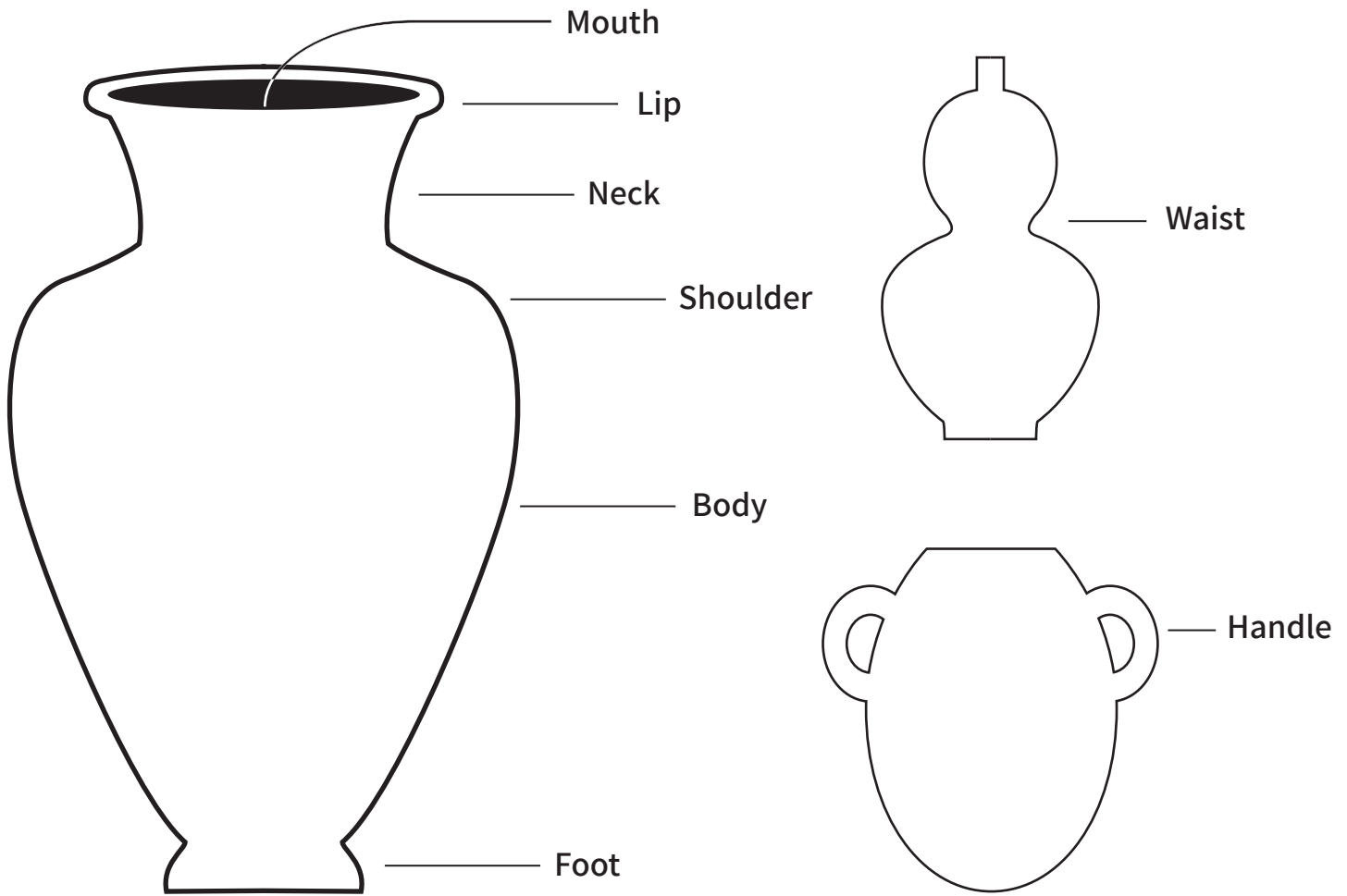


Anatomy of a Clay Vessel



Definitions

Mouth: Top opening of a round ware such as a bowl, jar or a vase

Lip: the rim or outside edge of the mouth

Neck: The narrow part of the vessel between the shoulder and lip

Shoulder: Outward curve of a vase under the neck or mouth

Body: The main, usually largest part of a vessel, part that holds the vessel's contents

Foot: The bottom projection of the vessel upon which it stands

Waist: Decorative inward curve on the body

Handle: a projection by which a vessel is held or carried
