Criteria for 2 pictures

- CLOSE-UP. You may be doing something in the picture, but it should be PORTRAIT and not a figure.
- II. CLEAR, high quality photos. Nothing fuzzy or out of focus.
 - CONTRAST/COLOR-
 - A. VALUE contrast to show form
 - 1. Highlights in the shadows, especially the eye
 - 2. Shadows in the lights
 - B. COLOR Keep the image color, not black and white
- IV. Strong Composition
 - A. You will crop and possibly tilt your photo to create a dynamic image

Think about these composition tips:

 Seventy-five % Positive Space (your face!)

- MOVEMENT to create interest in your artwork!!!








Paper Prep This will take longer than you think. Consider doing it when bing watching shows. Start now! :)



HOW TO PHOTOGRAPH YOUR ARTWORK




LIGHTING

Natural light is best on a cloudy or overcast day. This way the light is evenly spread across the artwork with no glares or shadows. You should not need a flash in this set up. It's best to tape/pin your artwork on a wall rather than lying flat on a table.





Photograph your Work-in-Progress

CAMERA ANGLE

Position the camera so it's facing the artwork head-on: the lens should line up with the center of the subject, and not tilted one way or another. In other words, the plane of the artwork should be parallel to the back of your camera — or you'll get a trapezoid instead of a rectangle. Use the grid feature on your phone to line up the edge of the paper parallel with the grid lines.




EDIT

dit your photo in any app you prefer: PicMonkey.com is a free website, but most phones have editing ability built into the phones camera app. Zoom in and crop out the packground so that the image is just your artwork. Adjust color and lighting to best esemble the actual artwork.

Please use sunlight from north facing window, whenever possible!


