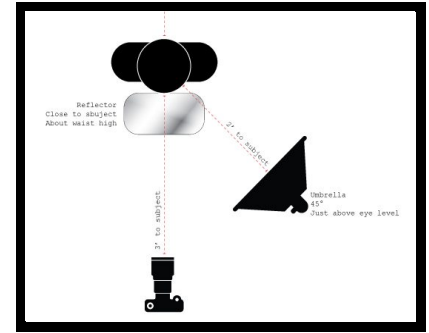

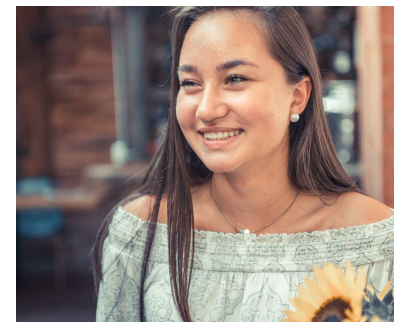
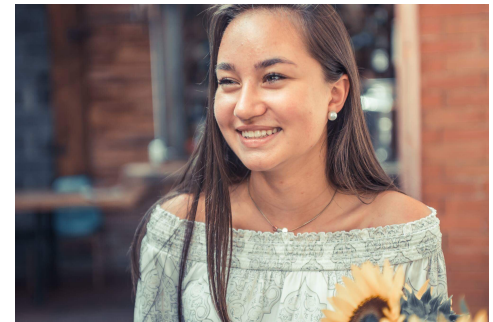


2 Expressive Selfies - *You may take more after, but let's start the dialog now! :)*

1. Take NEW pictures, not something from your phone.
2. Make them very different from each other
3. Create a mood. Get a reaction. Tell a story. Make me interested!

Criteria for 2 pictures

- I. **CLOSE-UP.** You may be doing something in the picture, but it should be PORTRAIT and not a figure.
- II. **CLEAR,** high quality photos. Nothing fuzzy or out of focus.
- III. **CONTRAST/COLOR-**
 - A. **VALUE** contrast to show form
 - 1. Highlights in the shadows, especially the eye
 - 2. Shadows in the lights
 - B. **COLOR** - Keep the image color, not black and white
- IV. **Strong Composition**
 - A. You will crop and possibly tilt your photo to create a dynamic image



Think about these composition tips:

- ❖ Diagonals - Head tilt, Eye's looking, Camera positioning
- ❖ Cropping -----> -----> ----->
- ❖ Overlapping - Hair, hand, clothes, background, prop
- ❖ Breaking up negative space
- ❖ Rule of Thirds - Consider if doing an asymmetrical composition
- ❖ Asymmetrical Balance - Negative matters. Consider how you will address it in your work BEFORE you begin
- ❖ Seventy-five % Positive Space (your face!)

Think about Principles such as:

- ❖ **MOVEMENT** to create interest in your artwork!!!
- ❖ **VARIETY** of shapes within the artwork!!!
- ❖ **CONTRAST** contrast of values!!!
