


Zentangle Inspired 3D Slab Initial



- 1. Pick your font. Think about the letter for your initial. You want it to have some personality. Think about the complexity of the shape as well. It also needs to be able to stand. Which one of these Ks would be easier? Why?
- 2. Print your letter out. Your letters should fill the page.
- 3. Roll your level slab.
- 4. Lay the cut out letter on top and trace, cutting through the clay. Be careful not to bevel your cut. See illustration B below.
- 5. Stack them and then open like a book. See illustration B below.
- 6. Score around the edges.



- 7. Cut side panels, be sure to keep it the same with. Score the sides. See image C below.
- 8. Add slip and quickly place the slap wall on. Use side on, the first side often needs some support to stay upright. Mend the edges with tools to connect.
- 9. Repeat until you are done. Keep an eye on the moisture of all the pieces. You can use plastic to slow drying down, even a light spritze of water. Also, don't put a side on if hasn't stiffened up some, it will droop and sitort.
- 10. Keep adding sides. Slip, score and mend at corners too. until you can then add the top on.
- 11. When addint the top, make sure the slab can hold it's shape. Some students opt to put some
