Shepard Fairey is an American contemporary street artist, muralist, graphic designer, activist, illustrator, and entrepreneur. He may be best known for creating President Barack Obama's iconic 2008 **Hope** election poster.

The Hope poster was not Fairey's first activist experience. Topics he explores include abuse of power, environmental destruction, racism, xenophobia, gender inequality, propaganda, war and peace, and economic imperialism.

- Fairey has expressed, "Art is not always meant to be decorative or soothing, in fact it can create uncomfortable conversations and emotions." Do you agree or not agree?
