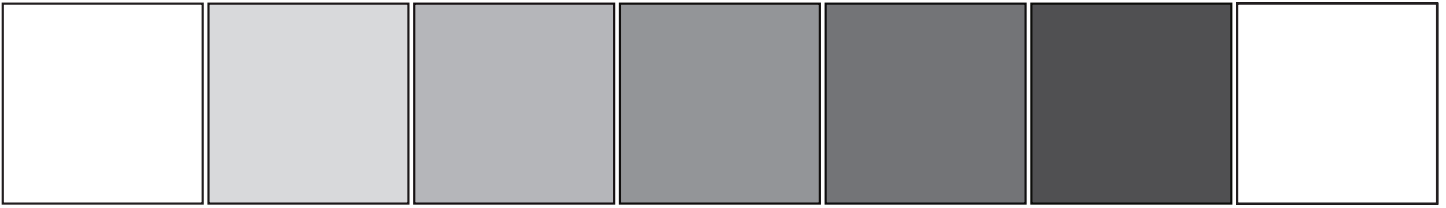


# Value

---

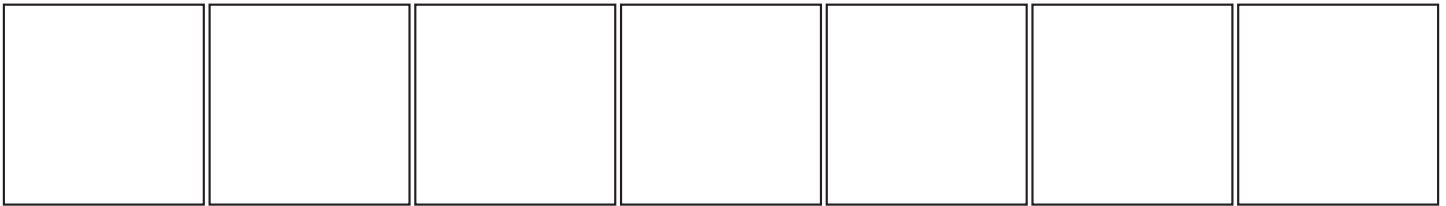


A value scale is a series of boxes filled with tone, that go from light to dark value in equal steps.

The difference between the lightest and darkest value is called "value range".



In the below boxes you will be creating your own value range. You can leave the first box the white of the paper. In the second box, try to emulate the shade you see in the second box above by hatching very lightly. Hatching is an art technique used to create tonal or shading effects by drawing closely spaced parallel lines. The pressure applied and density of lines will control the value.



Now, in the empty square below lightly draw the shape of the droplet and the droplet's cast shadow. Then shade carefully using hatching to replicate the values you observe in the photograph.
