


Woven Star Ornament


1. Start by cutting a six inch square using found or made decorative paper. It looks nice when the paper has contrasting colors on the sides.

2. Cut each square into six .5 inch strips.


3. Find and mark the center of two strips. Glue so they form a cross. (ill. 1)



4. Add two more strips to the right and left of the the first vertical strip. Alternate the weaving pattern and tack with glue where they overlap. Repeat with the horizontal set. (ill. 2)



5. Turn the piece 45 degrees. Bend two strips (ill. 3) until they overlap. Glue and hold until they hold the shape. Repeat.



6. Repeat processes 1-5 with the remaining six strips.

7. Keep one piece as is. Rotate the second piece by 45 degrees. Flip the second piece over and overlap the pieces. The pieces will not sit flatly but rather with space between. (ill. 4)

8. Thread the straight strip through the points end. Tack with glue and cut off excess. Create a loop with string, tack with glue and hang.
